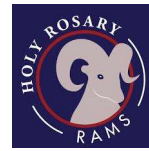




Holy Rosary Edmonds School Dance

Holy Rosary Edmonds (HRE School) is sponsoring a dance on **April 12, 2024, from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm** in the gym. The admission is \$10.00 and is paid at the door. 1 complimentary bottle of water is provided. All 7th and 8th grade students from HRE School, St. Luke School, St. Brendan School; St. Mark School, Our Lady of the Lake School; Assumption St. Bridget School and the Snohomish Deanery (St. Pius School; St. Thomas More School; St. Mary Magdalen School; Our Lady of Hope School; Immaculate Conception/OLPH School; St. Michael School; Immaculate Conception Regional School; Church of Assumption School) are welcome.

HRE School reserves the right to delay or refuse admittance for dress code violations.

Guidelines

- Only students from invited schools with **permission slips and student ID** are welcome.
- Students are expected to respect all school and parish property and other persons in attendance.
- Alcohol, tobacco, and drugs, in possession or consumed, will be cause for removal from the dance and/or referral to the police.
- No obscene language or clothing will be allowed.
- No gum chewing is allowed.
- No hats, coats, purses, vests, backpacks, sports bags are allowed in the gym during the dance. Coat-check will be available.
- No cell phones, i-phones, i-pods, camera phones, laser pointers, or any other electronic devices are allowed in the gym. This includes any device that can capture images, videos, or record any events of the dance. Cell phone check will be available.
- Inappropriate styles of dances are not acceptable. Students may not dance on tables or chairs.
- Students may not leave the gym at any time during the dance until a parent has arrived to pick them up.

Dress Code

All students are expected to dress appropriately. Clothing must be in good repair and fit the wearer properly, neither too large nor too small. There should be no holes or tears or signs of excessive wear. The clothing, messages, logos, pictures, drawings, or slogans may not conflict with Catholic values. Camouflage and paramilitary attire are not acceptable. **No heels or booties/boots with heels, strapless shirts, tight skirts, short skirts or shorts, low-rise pants, tank tops, halter-tops, or spaghetti straps are allowed. Shorts and skirts should be three inches above the knee or longer.** (Pencil-skirts need to adhere to these regulations). **HRE School reserve the right to delay admittance for dress code violations not limited to the above.**

Non-compliance with the above guidelines and dress code policy will result in direct communication with parents and/or school administrators.

I understand that this event will take place on school/parish grounds, and that all adult chaperones will be present throughout the dance. My child agrees to abide by all guidelines set forth by the event sponsors. As parent or legal guardian, I am legally responsible for that which may result from any personal actions taken by my child during this event. I agree to release and hold harmless HRE School, the Archdiocese of Seattle, and their agents and employees, from financial responsibility incurred as a result of my child's participation. In the event of an emergency, where medical treatment is required, I give permission to an adult leader to obtain services of an EMT, physician, or hospital staff. I will be notified as soon as possible in such an emergency. I will pick-up my child or arrange for transportation **NO LATER THAN 9:00 PM.**
